Name, date, and word count

One-inch top and bottom margins

## Essay Topic

Double space between the topic and the first paragraph

Over the years, there have been many important people in my life. There is one, however, that stands out more than the rest. Ever since I was 13, I have been taking Tae Kwon Do classes at *MS World 12-point Arial on Times New Roman font*. My instructor is Master Julius Melegrito and he played an essential role during my high school years. *Single space paragraphs* I gain a lot of confidence and self-respect; this helped me to achieve many goals in my school.

Double space between paragraphs - Enter and start typing on the second line

A year after joining Martial Arts International, Master Julius placed me in the advanced level adult class and invited to join the Black Belt Club. This is a prestigious club for martial artists that have made a goal to achieve their Black Belts. Another year later, after my Freshmen year in high school, he put me in the Leadership Team. This is for students who will become Assistant Instructors and, eventually, full Black *Single space paragraphs*. Then, he invited me to join the Demo Team, which is for students who do special performances for many different public occasions. On October 27<sup>th</sup> of the year 2007, I tested for my Black Belt, it was a six hour testing. On December 15th, I ceremonially received my Black Belt. It took me four years to earn my Black Belt, and I count it as the *1.25 left & right margins* most important of my high school career. I couldn't have *1.25 left & right margins* done it without Master Julius's encouragement and assistance. All of the extra activities Master Julius placed me in gave me more responsibility in his school; it showed how much confidence and trust he had in me. As a result, I began to be more confident.

Double space between paragraphs - Enter and start typing on the second line

By helping me to earn my Black Belt, Master Julius taught me an important lesson; there is no goal that is too high to reach. So, I began to reach for what I originally thought was impossible. Thanks to Master Julius, I now have two options for college; I am an alternate for the United States Air Force Academy and I have an AFROTC scholarship; I have also been accepted into Texas A&M University and the Corps of Cadets.

Almost from the very beginning, Master Julius put me in leadership positions within his school as an Assistant Instructor and then as a Black Belt Instructor. This affected my other activities; I gained many more leadership positions during my high school years. In my Youth Group, I became one of the youth group planners and leaders. I became a Varsity Public Forum Debater within my first year of taking debate. And in my JROTC group I held numerous leadership roles; Flight Commander, Kitty Hawk Air Society Secretary, and Chief of Operations to name a few. All of this was only possible because Master Julius refused to let me stay the quiet, shy girl I was when I first joined his school; he turned me into a leader.





## Rules & Eligibility

To enter, write and submit a one page essay on the topic: *What do the words to America the Beautiful mean to me?*

### \*Essays must be:

- One page, 500 words or less (excluding title) Essays exceeding one page and 500 words (excluding title) will be disqualified
- Typed in MS Word 12-point Arial or Times New Roman font
- Single-spaced, with double-spacing between paragraphs  
*(see sample on the back of this brochure)*
- One-inch top and bottom margin, and 1.25 inch left and right margin
- Submitted on CD

### \*Essay package must include:

- CD containing essay with participant's name, date and word count (don't put Social Security Number on the disk or essay)
- Entry form included in this brochure (photocopies accepted)  
Make sure all information marked with an asterisk\* is provided
- Current College/University acceptance letter for new students or official transcripts for those students already enrolled

**Important Notice:** Incomplete and/or inaccurate information on the entry form will result in disqualification. Submit your entry to your installation Force Support Squadron point of contact no later than **Monday, July 2, 2012**. Final scholarship awards will be announced on **Monday, September 17, 2012**. All entries received by HQ AFSVA/SVOFN will be advised of scholarship selection or non-selection. Only one essay per eligible person will be accepted. Winners must agree to provide information required for HQ AFSVA/SVF to make electronic funds transfer payment to their financial institution (see entry form)

Air Force Club members in good standing and their family members ID card holder (e.g. spouse, son, daughter, stepson and stepdaughter) who have been accepted by or are enrolled in an accredited college or university for entry during the fall of 2012 term as a part-time or full-time student are eligible. **Applicants must provide a copy of their college or university acceptance letter or latest transcripts.** Student enrollment status may involve either undergraduate or graduate curriculum. Grandchildren who are dependents (ID card holders) of the club member are also eligible. Force Support Squadron commanders/civilian directors, deputy commanders, division chiefs, flight chiefs, club managers, assistant club managers, and marketing directors, staffs of MAJCOMs, HQ AFSVA and HQ USAF/A1S, and family members of these individuals, are not eligible to participate.

**Scholarship Tip #1 – Follow directions, have someone look over your entry form and essay to check for errors; pay specific attention to spelling, grammar and spacing... line spacing must be 1.0**

**Scholarship Tip #2 – Begin early!! Don't wait until the last minute; you may turn in your package early**

**\*These requirements are strictly enforced.**

**Not meeting these requirements will result in disqualification.**

Essay must be typed in MS Word 12-point Arial or Times New Roman font. **All essay packages must be submitted to the installation Force Support Squadron point of contact by Monday, 2 July 2012.**
