

1. Air Force Services Activity Child and Youth Programs are pleased to announce the 2016 Operation Megaphone (OMP) Lock-In, 29-30 Apr 16!
2. In 2012 the Joint Service Teen Council (JSTC) created OMP, a worldwide overnight lock-in for all military youth to celebrate being a military youth. Since then, OMP has become a worldwide event attracting and connecting teens from every facet of the military. OMP provides teens the opportunity to connect via social media to compete in challenges, host teen leadership meetings, discuss military teen issues, extend invites to various distinguished visitors, collaborate with the other branches of the military service and support their community with civic engagement.
3. This year over 100 teens voted on the theme and service project, choosing the theme of "Military Teens Globally Connected Familiar Faces in Different Places" along with the 2016 Service Project "Celebrating Our Service Members."
